GENERAL

Texel International Airport had a good flying year in 2008. We registered 24,007 movements and that made it the best year since 1999. Compared with 2007 we showed an increase of 16%.

The reason for the increase was primarily the good runway state. The airport was only closed for fixed-wing aircraft for 12 days and on another 12 days there was limited opening. In 2002, the year preceding the major reconstruction, Texel Airport was closed for a total of 76 days and had limited opening on another 63 days.

The first quarter of 2009 was also positive despite the winter weather. The months of January and March have never been so busy in the last 10 years and with a total of 3,364 movements it was the busiest first quarter of the millennium.

We hope to welcome many more diverse aircraft in the coming months.

YOU ARE WELCOME FOR TOUCH & GO'S

During the week it is dirt cheap to practice **Touch & Go's** at Texel Airport. From € **3,99** per Touch you are welcome to practice your landings on the best grass runway in The Netherlands. Jets and aircraft weighing more than 6,000kg, such as Citations, Dornier 228 and Helicopters are more than welcome on Texel!

During the summer weekends Touch & Go's are more expensive, beginning at € 7,25 The longer runway (22-04) with it's 1,115m (1,245m from ditch to ditch) has been totally renovated. We now have virtually no problems with standing water and the runway surface is extremely smooth. Heavier aircraft are nevertheless advised to check with the Airport Manager in advance.

On 4th March 2009 Texel was visited for the very first time by an Embraer EMB-121 Xingu, the OO-SXC from Air Venture in Antwerp. OLT from Germany transported a delegation from Texel on 19th and 20th March with an Airvan and an Islander.







In March we welcomed the D-HORG from Rotorflug, which is used to inspect the dikes. The Pitts PH-WDY left for its home-base of Den Helder on 19th March after being restored by Vliegtuigonderhoud Texel. The same day a Netherlands Royal Air Force Chinook came to pass the time on Texel while waiting for clearance to the Romeo Four on Vlieland.

CIRCUIT AT 1000FT THROUGHOUT THE YEAR

The Dutch AIP will from the beginning of May show the published Texel circuit attitude at 1000ft instead of 700ft. From 1st April until 1st October the weekend procedures are in force, meaning that only during weekends the Reporting Points must be used. The procedures are shown on www.texelairport.nl under "Pilot Information".

FUEL FROM BP AIR

BP is the sole supplier of fuel at Texel Airport and the BP recommended prices are in force. The current fuel prices can be found on www.texelairport.nl under "Landing Fees".

Unfortunately it is not possible to use the BP-Carnet any more to pay for fuel at Texel Airport, since BP has stopped accepting the carnets throughout the Benelux. The card readers at Lelystad and Rotterdam will shortly be replaced by PIN terminals.

Of course you can still obtain AVGAS 100LL and Jet A1 fuel at Texel. Payment by cash, PIN, Credit Card (VISA or Eurocard) or after negotiation on credit.

AIRPORT RESTAURANT
